## What are VESA sizes?



VESA have developed a set of standards for the display industry, including the common mounting holes found on the back of almost all TVs and monitors. This makes it easier to find the ideal wall mount.

The Ross range is colour coded on the packaging to show the VESA compatibility and our suggested TV sizes which relate to that VESA size:

If you have a $42^{\prime \prime}$ TV, it is highly likely to be compatible with both our $200 \times 200$ and $400 \times 400$ VESA TV mounts and you could choose from either range.

You can also use our Mount Finder tool on our website www.ross.ulk, which asks a few basic questions to help you find the correct VESA size.


You can confirm the right size by measuring the spacing between the four mounting holes on the back of the screen. Write down the result in millimetres, left-toright first, then top-to-bottom. e.g. $\mathbf{2 0 0 \times 2 0 0}$

It may be difficult to reach depending on where the TV is located and if it is already connected up. You may prefer to check the user manual or manufacturer's website instead.
